### **Right Worshipful Junior Grand Warden Tommie Wright**

Tommie Wright proudly hails from Brevard County, Florida, and was raised in the city of Cocoa. He is the son of the late Mr. Tommie Wright, Jr., founder of Wright's Janitorial Services, and Mrs. Maggie Kimbrough Wright, a retired NASA Personnel Director at Kennedy Space Center, as well as a former educator and administrator.

Brother Wright received his education through the Brevard County school system and graduated in the spring of 1990. He went on to attend Auburn University in Auburn, Alabama, where he earned a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration. Following college, he enlisted in the United States Navy, serving as an Aviation Administrationman Second Class (AZ2) until 2000. After his military service, he began his professional career at Kennedy Space Center, where he currently holds the position of Director of Sales.

Brother Tommie Wright comes from a proud lineage of Masons, including his grandfather, several uncles, and numerous cousins. Inspired by their legacy, he entered the Masonic Order in 2009, where he was initiated, passed, and raised in Indian River Lodge No. 85 in Titusville, Florida, under the leadership of Worshipful Master Fletcher Portlock. From the outset, Brother Wright demonstrated a strong commitment to service, taking on leadership roles as Chairman of both the Fundraising and Audit Committees during his first year. His dedication and leadership were quickly recognized, and in 2010, he was unanimously elected Senior Warden. The following year, in November 2011, he was elected and installed as Worshipful Master of the Lodge - now known as Leroy G. Smith Lodge No. 85. During his tenure, which concluded in 2014, Brother Wright led significant growth in membership and established a solid financial foundation. His leadership enabled the Lodge to award two annual scholarships and provide continued support to Percy C. Taylor Council No. 15, Knights of Pythagoras.
